His wife, Mary, was a housewife who doted on her only son. MUSIC IN NARRATOR (VO) Something begins to change for Warren during high school. The once happy and outgoing child becomes increasingly anti-social and begins to live a life of solitude.

NARRATOR (VO) His parents begin to become concerned when he spends most of his time alone in his room listening to music and playing his guitar. JACK EVANS Warren, you need to think about your future. If you want to get anywhere in life, you need a college education. WARREN EVANS Musicians don't need diplomas. JACK EVANS Warren, you can't make a living and support a family by playing music. You need to be responsible.
